



## **BSBMTCT JOHN GOLDMAN PRIZE**

### **Haematology Registrars, Fellows and Young Investigators working in the field of Transplantation**

Submit your abstract to the Annual BSBMTCT Scientific Meeting to be considered for a BSBMTCT travel grant to EBMT and for the chance to win a BSBMTCT **John Goldman Prize** worth £500.

Abstracts in clinical research or basic science already submitted to EBMT are welcome. Shortlisted candidates will give a 10-minute oral presentation at the Annual BSBMTCT Scientific Meeting on 7th May 2020 in London.

All short-listed candidates who require support to attend EBMT will receive a BSBMTCT travel grant. Two John Goldman Prizes will be selected from the shortlist, one in clinical research and one in basic science. The competition is a great opportunity to present your findings to an expert audience and enhance your CV!

Your abstract may relate to any clinical or scientific aspect of stem cell transplantation and should include a title, names and affiliations of authors, and your contact email address and telephone number. The body of the abstract should be no more than 300 words long. You must have made a significant contribution to the work and have the agreement of your co-authors to present.
